# **Quick Build Project Pilot Program**



- Quick Builds: Interim capital improvement projects that further the goals of the ATP
- Up to \$7 million will be awarded to Quick Build Projects
- New Due Date: July 15, 2020
  - Application on the <u>Caltrans ATP Website</u>
- Evaluation
- State-Only Funded
- Reporting Requirements

## **Scope & Plan Layout Consistency**



- Points for this question **increased** in all Infrastructure Apps:
  - Large from 2 points to 7 points
    - Combination of Scope & Plan Layout Consistency and Cost Effectiveness
  - Medium from 2 points to 5 points
  - Small from 2 points to 3 points
- Evaluators will be looking at consistency between 3 main elements:
  - Layouts and Maps
  - Engineer's Estimate
  - Project Schedule

### **Scope & Plan Layout Consistency**



- Caltrans held a workshop that laid out what applicants should be including in their application to be a PSR Equivalent and what is needed in order to be successful on this question

## **Performance Metrics**



- Performance Metrics will only be required for funded projects
- Performance Metrics that will be required:
  - Counts
    - Follow the Interim Count Methodology Guidance
    - Active Transportation Resource Center Loan Counter Program
  - Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities Benefits Calculator

## **Cost Increases**



- The Active Transportation Program does not fund cost increases
  - One exception: Caltrans Implemented Projects
    - Will only consider cost increase for Caltrans implemented projects
    - Caltrans cost increase requests must be approved by the Commission in the same manner as project cost increases for other Commission programs.

# **Clarifying Language**

- Removed duplicative language
- Extreme scores
- Emphasized importance of Attachments for several questions
- Connecting Part B to Part A
