

Create a paper friendship bracelet for your classroom

- **Print the Circles**

- Use this template and try to print on cardstock or sturdy paper
- Choose bright or varied colors for a cheerful look.

- **Cut Out the Circles**

- Pre-cut circles for younger students.
- Older students can cut their own for added involvement.

- **Introduce the Activity**

- Explain that each circle will represent a “link” in a friendship bracelet for the whole class.
- Share that the goal is to fill the bracelet with messages of kindness.

- **Write the Kindness Messages**

- Have each student write a short, positive message on their circle.
- Ideas include: compliments, words of encouragement, or ways to show kindness.

- **Decorate the Circles**

- Students can color, doodle, or add stickers to personalize their link.

- **Create the Bracelet**

- Punch two holes on opposite sides of each circle.
- Use yarn, ribbon, or string to connect the circles in a long chain or loop.

- **Display the Bracelet**

- Hang the completed “paper friendship bracelet” around the classroom door, bulletin board, or windows.
- Add a sign that says: “Our Class Friendship Bracelet – Made with Kindness”
