# Create a paper friendship bracelet for your classroom

## Print the Circles

- Use this template and try to print on cardstock or sturdy paper
- Choose bright or varied colors for a cheerful look.

## Cut Out the Circles

- Pre-cut circles for younger students.
- Older students can cut their own for added involvement.

# Introduce the Activity

- Explain that each circle will represent a "link" in a friendship bracelet for the whole class.
- Share that the goal is to fill the bracelet with messages of kindness.

## Write the Kindness Messages

- Have each student write a short, positive message on their circle.
- Ideas include: compliments, words of encouragement, or ways to show kindness.

## Decorate the Circles

• Students can color, doodle, or add stickers to personalize their link.

#### Create the Bracelet

- Punch two holes on opposite sides of each circle.
- Use yarn, ribbon, or string to connect the circles in a long chain or loop.

# Display the Bracelet

- Hang the completed "paper friendship bracelet" around the classroom door, bulletin board, or windows.
- Add a sign that says: "Our Class Friendship Bracelet Made with Kindness"
